# **DESCRIPTION**

The ares\_cancel(3) function cancels all lookups/requests made on the the name service channel identified by *channel*. ares\_cancel(3) invokes the callbacks for each pending query on the channel, passing a status of ARES\_ECANCELLED. These calls give the callbacks a chance to clean up any state which might have been stored in their arguments. If such a callback invocation adds a new request to the channel, that request will *not* be cancelled by the current invocation of ares\_cancel(3).
